

CARFEST SOUTH 2016

EVENT SUMMARY

CarFest South will operate for the fifth year in 2016, again taking place at Laverstoke Park Farm. The event will operate from Friday 26th to Sunday 28th August.

The event is the brainchild of Radio 2 breakfast show DJ Chris Evans and raises money for BBC Children in Need. It has a partner event, CarFest North, and between them they raised £2 million for the charity in 2015.

The festival has 4 key components - cars, music, food and families.

Cars:

This year we have changed our hill climb format! We still have the extended hill climb, however, we have swapped the sevens theme for the CarFest time tunnel! With cars from every decade since the first car hit our roads. There will be a maximum of two track shows a day:

Music:

Live music will operate from the main stage (two stages side by side) each evening - for a full line up head to the website www.carfest.org

Food:

VISITOR NUMBERS

Ticketed visitors per day: 18,800, of which up to 9,000 are campers. Staff, crew, guests, artists etc total 4,999.

CTM will be providing the traffic management expertise again this year and are liaising with HCC Highways dept regarding the implementation of a one way system again this year and speed limits on the roads around the event.
